It follows the fortunes of 3 fishing communities in Ireland, Newfoundland and Norway as their livelihoods come under threat from oil explorers and industrial trawlers in their fishing grounds. A follow on 'The Pipe', which told the story of the community at the centre of the centre of the Corrib Gas controversy, 'Atlantic' is narrated by Brendan Gleeson and won Best Irish Documentary' on its first outing at the Dublin International Film Festival.
