I would like to acknowledge with appreciation the following contributions towards the repairs and maintenance of Acres Church Windows: A donation of €200

€143.40 from the Acres Bargain Rail shop for forwarding the Textile cheques to our fund. All donations are welcome and appreciated. The cost of repair of each window is quite high, up to €5,000 for each around the back of the altar, which includes replacement glass for missing stained glass, re-leading around each piece of glass, and equipped with storm glazing for all windows, this time a breathable storm glaze that is powder coated aluminium with removable sections. Three of the side windows have been removed for work, while the rest seem to be in fair condition.

I propose to introduce a building fund to meet the costs of this refurbishment and also paint the chapel inside and our in the next year. Other fund raising events are welcome.
