Visitation

The Sick and housebound will be visited with Holy Communion on Thursday.

The instruction of the Church is that when a priest/minister is calling to your house with Holy Communion, that the house prepares a place for the visit, usually a cross, a candle and holy water. Also my own practice is that that if I bring communion to a house and there is no one there for two concurrent visits, I wait until the family contact me again before I resume the visits, with a view to ensuring that when the Lord calls, there is someone present to receive Him.
