An opportunity to participate in **PATHWAYS – An Adult Faith Development Programme (Raphoe Diocese)** in Gallagher's Hotel, Letterkenny.

Have you ever thought about exploring your faith.....or wished that you could broaden your understanding of your faith Found yourself longing to search for some kind of deeper meaning in life? ...
