Church Gate Collections

Church Gate Collections are collections that groups take up at our chapel gates during weekend Masses, taking advantage of the fact that a large group of people are gathering in one area. These collections have nothing to do with the church in any way. They have to get a permit from the gardai to take up these collections. They should be outside of church grounds, at the gate

or entrance of the grounds rather than at the church door.

People sometimes think these collections are church backed, or church organised. This is not so. In Acres Church, one can understand the confusion when one sees the collector handing out the bulletins to people as they come in to pray. I have tried to discourage this practice. I would prefer if the collectors stay outside of the chapel, preferably on the outside of the slabbed area, beyond the steel bollards. The practice in Kincasslagh is that these collections are at the church gate, hail rain or shine. I would also prefer if these collections are announced and thanked on the bulletin board, rather than the newsletter. So for the last time,
