"Irish Water Safety" will carry out both Swimming Lessons and Safety & Rescue training in the Keadue and Cruit areas as usual this summer. Dates have been confirmed as follows: Week one begins on Monday 13 July and the second week begins week beginning the 19th August ... Children may attend lessons for both weeks or choose one week which suits them best. Swim lessons will happen at a later time this year - the block yard beach in Keadue from 1 - 3 each day and are suitable for children aged from around 4 upwards. Registration will take place from 12 on both Monday mornings. Safety and rescue training will take place at the bridge in Cruit from 3 - 5 o clock, and is suitable for children over 12 years of age who are competent swimmers. Registration will take place at the bridge from 2.30. Adult safety and rescue sessions are being held for the first time this year and will take place in Cruit between 5.30 – 6.30 Cost for weekly sessions are €30 each family rates apply.
