Step into your Future -Are you an adult interested in returning to education or are currently engaged in learning and considering progression onto further study – then this event is for you - Donegal ETB Further Education & Training Fair – Mt Errigal Hotel, Letterkenny, Wednesday, 25th January 11am – 3.00 pm. Open and free to all adults.

The Catholic Primary Schools Management Association broadly welcomes the public consultation process on school admission policies announced by the Minster for Education and Science, Richard Bruton TD. However, it notes that the issues arising from it may well impact in adverse ways on minority groups and urges that these be taken properly into account. Responding to the Minister's announcement, Seamus Mulconry, General Secretary of Catholic Primary Schools Management Association, said, **"This issue is being misleadingly referred to as the 'baptism bar'**. It is important to clarify that there is no requirement for parents to have their children baptised in order to gain admission to a Catholic school.

"The issue the Minster is proposing to address only occurs in the small number of schools who are oversubscribed. The vast majority of Catholic schools are not oversubscribed and enrol all applicants. The issue mainly arises in areas of Dublin and in small pockets of the commuter belt surrounding the capital.

Reforms to admissions policies will do nothing to alleviate the shortage of school places: only extra school places can achieve that."

Faith for Life

Faith4Life is a new course designed to help you to discover more energising and empowering ways to live out your faith in the reality of today's world: through relationships, family, home, parish, work and the events of daily life. The Parishes of the Rosses has been in contact with the Archdioceses of Liverpool and Dublin with a view to setting it up here. Faith for life is a programme with four movements, each movement will involve coming together at a location in Dungloe for 12 hours of activity over a weekend, group work, education, and prayer, and also involves written work and small group meetings between the movements. In Dublin a participant said, "Faith for Life has been for me both a solitary and a shared journey. It has challenged the comfortable passive practice of my faith and life. and guided me along a path long ignored. It has become a compass for decision-making, faith development and right relationship with God and others. shaping my faith into a tool for social action."

The programme will start in February and is confined to 24 participants, so we are looking for 6 people from our parish that may be able to give up four weekends during the year to enhance their knowledge of their faith. Enquiries to the contacts on top of this newsletter.
