Hurricane Matthew blew it's way through Haiti on the 7th of October, almost 3 weeks ago now. It left a path of destruction behind it, with between 960-990 people dead. Flooding of up to 4ft water in a lot of areas. A 40ft steel container was swept away from some of the farmlands and found 2.5 miles down the road. I have been overwhelmed with the amount of concern people have with our projects in Haiti. Thankfully all the housed that have been built in the past 6 years have stood up to the forces that hurricane Matthew had thrown at them. The main damage to other houses was roofs blown off and some walls tossed because they were poorly built. 'Haven' is helping them by having a secure roof over their heads for their families. Thank you for your well wishes and concerns. As you know Megan and myself are travelling there in April and hope to do as much as we can on your behalf.
