Belcruit Graveyard

A number of comments have been received regarding the condition of our graveyard in Belcruit. While honouring the dead through prayer, visits and the placing of flowers and wreaths is a hightly commendable christian practice, it should be noted the timely disposal of the same should be considered at the time of placing. As flowers and wreaths will decay and die, it is only fitting that people who have brought them to the gravevard will also take responsibility for their removal. Everybody drives to the graveyard, and the removal of old weaths and dead flowers should not be a problem. The practice of throwing them over the wall of the graveyard or the sea wall is not at all acceptable, nor is leaving them at the gravevard gate, where they end up on other peoples graves.

I think the present litter has come from the placement of flowers and wreaths at our August Graveyard Service, and it is sad that something we do with such love and tenderness then has such an unhappy consequence as we approach the November Novena in their memory.
