



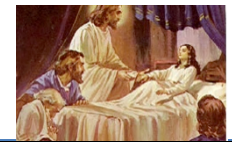

## Irish Water safety . CORRECT DATES

"Irish Water Safety" will carry out both **Swimming Lessons** and **Safety & Rescue training** in the Keadue and Cruit areas as usual this summer. Dates have been confirmed as follows: Week one begins on **Monday 13 July** and the second week begins week beginning the **10<sup>th</sup> August**. Children may attend lessons for both weeks or choose one week which suits them best. Swim lessons will happen at a later time this year - the block yard beach in **Keadue** from 1 - 3 **each day** and are suitable for children aged from around 4 upwards. Registration will take place from 12 on both Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July & 10<sup>th</sup> Aug Safety and rescue training will take place at the bridge in **Cruit** from 3 - 5 o'clock, and is suitable for children over 12 years of age who are competent swimmers. Registration will take place at the bridge from 2.30.

**Adult safety and rescue sessions** are being held for the first time this year and will take place in Cruit between 5.30 - 6.30. Cost for weekly sessions are €30 each family rates apply.
