On 12 January 2010, at 4:53pm local time, Haiti was struck by a magnitude-7.0 earthquake. This was the country's most severe earthquake in over 200 years. The 2010 Haiti earthquake was reported to have left up to between 46,000 & 85,000 people dead and 1.6 million homeless. The country has yet to recover from the 2010 earthquake and a subsequent and massive Haiti cholera outbreak. The country has yet to recover, due to the severity of the damage, as well as an ineffective government.

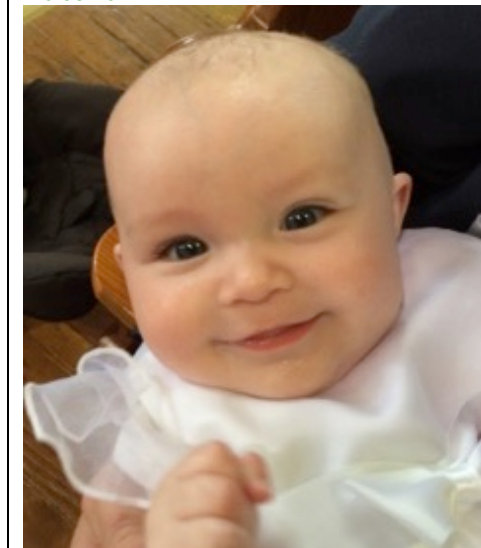
