National Church collection on 22/23 July

in aid of 25m people facing hunger crisis in east-Africa: Kenya, South Sudan, Somalia and Ethiopia
President Michael D. Higgins paid tribute to the decision by the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference to organise special collections at churches across Ireland, to raise funds for people affected by the famine in East-Africa. He called on all Irish citizens and organisations to take this call as an example and to respond with their traditional generosity. "As President of Ireland may I commend all such efforts to provide assistance to the people across the countries of East Africa, who are suffering the effects of a devastating drought. Three years of drought have created what the United Nations have called the greatest humanitarian crisis since the Second World War, with over 24 million people facing malnutrition and starvation. Our shared humanity demands no less."

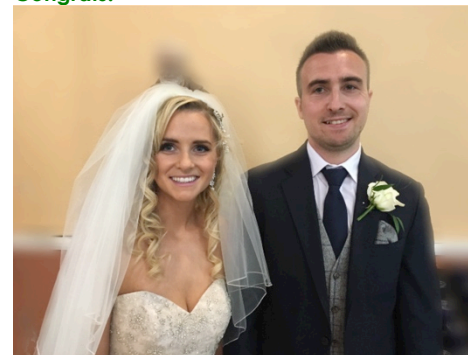
