Blessing of Graves

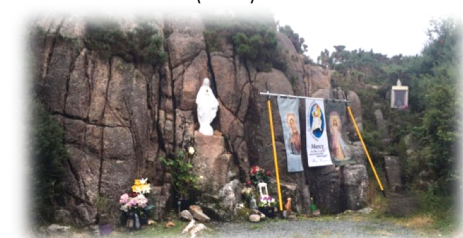
The Blessing of graves will take place this weekend.
