

## Irish Water Safety

"Irish Water Safety" will carry out both Swimming Lessons and Safety & Rescue training in the Keadue and Cruit areas as usual this summer. Dates have been confirmed as follows: Week one begins on **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July** and the second week begins week beginning the **11<sup>th</sup> August**. Children may attend lessons for both weeks or choose one week that suits them best. Swim lessons will happen at the block yard beach in Keadue from 10 each morning and are suitable for children aged from around 4 upwards. Registration will take place from 9.30 on both Monday mornings. Safety and rescue training will take place at the bridge in Cruit from 1 o'clock, and is suitable for children over 12 years of age who are competent swimmers. Registration will take place at the bridge from one. Cost per child for weekly sessions are €30.
