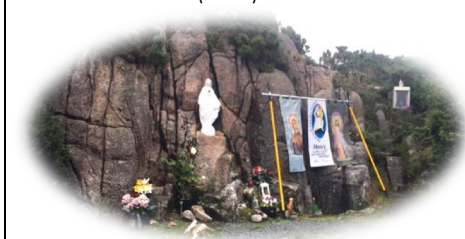

AUGUST CAMINO (walk) TO KERRYTOWN

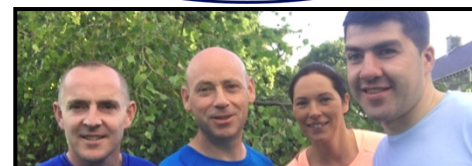


If Hurricane Gert doesn't visit the timetable for the Camino of the Assumption is as follows:
