Mass Intentions

When booking a Mass for the deceased in the chapels of our parish, many people look for a weekend Mass so that the family can attend and pray for that intention. This is to be commended and a worthy practice. However, I have found in recent times that almost all Masses are now requested at weekends, and there is a growing feeling that if the family cannot attend, then the mass will not be offered.

Each priest offers Mass most days of the week, and can offer that for your intention. The fact that it cannot be on a particular day that people were looking for should not take away from the value of offering that Mass. So I suggest that, if a weekend Mass is not free, the offering of your intention would take place during the week, knowing that it will be mentioned on the weekend before when the family could be present, or simply requesting that the person be remembered at the weekend Masses.
