## SMA Mission Awareness



Next Week please welcome one of the SMA mission priests who has been given permission to visit the Churches of the Diocese to promote Mission Awareness. The Society of African Missions (SMA Fathers) was founded in France in 1856 and when it was established in Ireland in 1878 it was the first exclusively missionary congregation to send out missionaries from Ireland. The main mission of the SMA is in Africa where members work in 17 countries. Today, there are about 800 members and about 300 seminarians preparing to be missionaries. The SMA asks for the support of prayers for the success of its missionary works. Our greatest need is funds to educate our seminarians and to continue the work of

our priests among some of the poorest people on earth. An SMA priest will visit the parish on Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th September to speak at all the masses about the work of the SMA Fathers.
