## Purgatory

We should pray for the souls in Purgatory; perhaps the deceased is there. None of us can presume upon God's mercy. The ancient tradition of the Church is that those souls assisted by our prayers are made aware of this, so that they may intercede for us from Heaven. There is a beauty to this relationship of interdependence: the souls in Purgatory depend on the living to pray for them; we in this world rely on their intercession once they are admitted to eternal life with God. I think often at this time of my ancestors – those who have gone before me, without whom I would not be here – and the debt of gratitude I owe to them. And I pray for their souls, and for the souls of all those who have died, especially those who have no-one to pray for them.

This is how the dead accompany us. Not as the gruesome spectres or gory corpses of the costumed revellers of Halloween parties. But as friends, as helpers, and as those in need of our help. This November, remember the dead. Remember that you will be one of them, and pray for them.
