Day of Prayer for Survivors of Abuse

A day of prayer for survivors of abuse will take place on Friday 15th February 2019, just one week before the gathering of Bishops with Pope Francis in Rome to discuss the safeguarding of minors in the Church. Francis and the bishops will participate in a penitential liturgy to ask forgiveness for the whole church. In preparation for this meeting, Archbishop Eamon Martin has been receiving feedback from a variety of people, including survivors of abuse. Many have spoken about the importance of prayer for survivors, and for atonement in the Church. At 10 am Mass in the Cathedral, Bishop Alan will light a candle of atonement and pray the atonement prayer, a ceremony to be repeated in all Cathedrals in Ireland. He asks us to do the same in our parishes and to pray for the success of the meeting in Rome. To that end we will also light a candle in our Chapels on Friday 15th February at 10.00 a.m. and the prayer of atonement will be offered. The prayer, composed by Pope Francis will be available all day by the candle for people who wish to drop in and pray.

Candle of Atonement Prayer

Lord, forgive our many sins.

We grieve and repent with all our hearts for having offended you, for our great failings and neglect of the young and vulnerable. We place all of those who have been hurt by the Church in any way into your loving hands and under the protection of Our Blessed Mother.

Lord, bring peace to their broken lives and show us all the way out of darkness and into the light of your Word.

May we as a people of God be more fully human, more fully Christ-like and more fully your people, that we may see the errors of the past and go forward with renewed hope and faith in Christ and in our Church. Amen.
