Anyone who attends the Alzheimer's Café can receive support, information, education about Dementia, and meet others in similar circumstances. They also meet professionals knowledgeable about Dementia, members of the local Alzheimer's Society or any other

Dementia Support Group. Anyone living with Dementia, irrespective of what stage their illness is at are invited to attend the café.

Over the last two years various professionals have delivered talks, engaged in discussions and question and answer sessions with people living with Dementia and their carers. The Café hope to celebrate the second anniversary on June 6<sup>th</sup> 2019 with a party. The setting will be informal with song and dance and light refreshments
