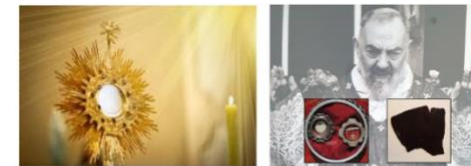
Burtonport Festival
