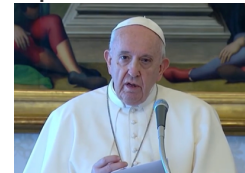
## Very Rev Hugh Sweeney, PP, Glenswilly

## Pope Francis asks something of us this week
