Is there a Sunday Obligation? No. We would ask you to at present only go to Mass once a week, and choose a day that suits you. When the chapel is full/reached the numbers allowed by government, the doors will be closed.

Will there be a collection? Yes, but we will ask you to drop your contribution in a box upon entry.

Will there be a choir? Not at present, but we can have one musician and one singer.

Will there be clerks? Not just yet.

Can we book a place for an anniversary Mass or Months mind? Yes, if you contact me with what you will need I can reserve seats.

Is there a chance I will arrive and not get in? Yes, unfortunately, until we begin to open and

figure out how to do this safely.

Can we have Baptisms? Yes, providing there is physical distancing.

Can we have weddings? Yes, providing there is physical distancing.

Can I have Confessions? Yes, after Masses ensuring physical distancing.

We would ask that you ring the priest or use online services to book Masses, rituals, rather than meet him in the sacristv.

What else do you need to open safely?

Support from the community by way of sanitising and stewarding, i.e., closing the doors and ensuring entry and exit is done with physical distancina in mind.
