

Divine Mercy Sunday 3pm Sunday 11th

Do these three things on Divine Mercy Sunday with the intention to turn away from sin in your life:

Make an Act of Contrition

If you are unable to get to Confession, make an Act of Contrition, instead, with the intention of receiving sacramental Confession as soon as possible

Make a Spiritual Communion

Since churches are closed and you cannot receive Holy Communion, make a Spiritual Communion instead

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Blessed Sacrament. Hove You above all things and I desire You in my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if You were already there and unite myself to You; permit not that I should ever be separated from You. Amen.

Again, do this act of trust with the intent to return to the sacrament of Holy Communion as soon as possible.

Say a prayer like this:

Lord Jesus Christ, You promised St. Faustina that the soul that has been to Confession [I'm unable, but I made an Act of Contrition] and the soul that receives Holy Communion [I'm unable, but I made a Spiritual Communion] will receive the complete forgiveness of all sins and punishment. Please, Lord Jesus Christ, give me this grace.
