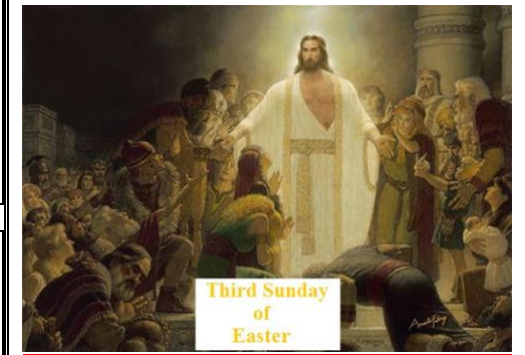

Jesus is keen to reassure his friends that he is not a ghost, but the same one as before, though in a new state. The strongest proof of this identity are his wounds, a clear sign that 'that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day'. Yet they are also signs that 'repentance and the forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations.' Death and life are closely linked, yet life has the last word.

Jesus tells his friends that they are to be his witnesses. He asks that of me too, and I pray to be a faithful witness of the Resurrection and of the good news about the forgiveness of sins. Like the Apostles, I can only witness what I have already experienced, and I ask for a heart open to Jesus' presence in my life.
