

Maintenance St. Columba's Church As you can see the north wall of our

church in Burtonport is in bad shape. This has been due to the continuing failure of the auttering which has been allowing water to penetrate the wall and is causing the blistering and falling away of plaster on the inside of the wall. It seems we need to take two courses of action, 1. Replace the existing autters. and 2. insert flashing underneath the autters so that any spill from the autters will be directed away from penetrating the wall itself.

Work will start next week with scaffold (€3250) +VAT and Gutterina and downpipes and flashing (€6840)+VAT. The wall will need the rest of the summer to dry out before we can paint it again. Any with funding this will be greatly appreciated.
