ADULT FAITH FORMATION

The Diocese is excited to launch our programme for the month of May - **Meditating with Mary in the month of May**. This follows on from the hugely successful Lenten programme **No Greater Love** which took place in 10 parishes and had over 120 people take part in it.

The launch of **'Meditating with Mary in the month of May'** will be on **Monday 25th April** at the **Pastoral Centre in Letterkenny**. The evening will start at **7pm**, we aim to conclude by 8.30pm.

Meditating with Mary in the month of May, is a 3-week programme which provides an opportunity to come together as a parish community to meditate on three joyful moments in the life of Mary; the Annunciation and the Visitation which culminate in Mary's song of praise to God, the Magnificat.

Together you will reflect on these moments of encounter in her life as you meditate on the Gospel of Luke. As you read through a selected number of texts, you will have an opportunity to understand more deeply Mary as the model of discipleship for the Church. This programme will also give you an opportunity to reflect on the Scriptures, share your insights, pray together, and learn about the ways in which Sacred Art can inspire your understanding of these aspects of Mary's life. As you gather together each week, let it be an opportunity for you to follow the example of Mary so that God's Word can become a life-giving encounter for each one of us.

This will be a three-week programme so it's not too much of a time commitment and that if it doesn't start in the first week of May there is still scope for parishes to join in a little later.

Essentially the programme is - scripture, lectio, reflection from Pope Francis' WYD messages and then a litany/prayer for each of the weeks. Each parish can mix it up with adding hymns, running it in the Church or a hall, running it with a secondary schools or nursing home etc. It can be adapted to suit your parishes needs. We will run over this at the launch evening.

Please **RSVP by 1pm on Friday 22nd April** with how many parish representatives will be coming from your parish, any dietary requirements, and an idea of how many books you would like. The books are €1.50 each and can be collected on the evening.
