Lectio Divina is an ancient practise of the Church. Simply speaking it's a way to pray with the Scriptures. Each day has 4 stages of prayer: you read, meditate, pray and contemplate the word of God. Sounds intimidating? Fear not! You will receive an introduction to each of them (a talk with all the information that you need about

how to pray and what to do/ avoid). We, the Sisters, will guide you through this time and if you will have any questions or needs, we are there for you.

This silent retreat starts on Friday at 06:00 p.m. and ends after lunch (about 02:00 p.m.) on Sunday. The retreat teaches how to do Lectio Divina and gives you a chance to practice it. It is a time of silence and a time to meet with God in the depths of your heart, through the Scripture. We will be praying with the Gospel that speaks so much about Divine Mercy: The Parable of the Merciful Father in Luke 15:11-32 (more widely known as the Parable of the Prodigal Son).
