Keadue Rovers Bingo Results 14/6/2022

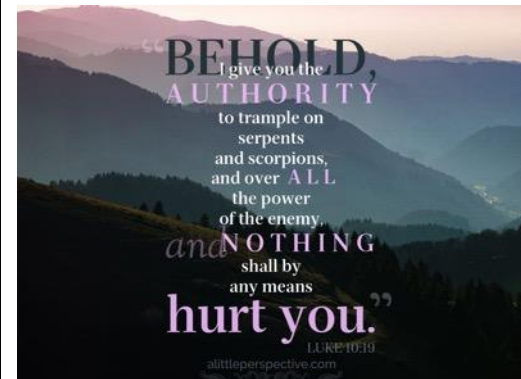
