Niall served in Dungloe as Curate many years ago and after working in University in Belfast with a hand in many other academic pastures, Niall was recently appointed Parish Priest of Drumholm, And Tawnawilly and (Donegal and Clár). A gifted theologian and academic, Niall is also blessed with a generous personality and kind spirit. He also served as Chaplain to St. Eunan's College.

Niall was ordained to the priesthood in July 1988 along with Fr. Pat Ward, Arranmore, Fr. Paddy Dunne, Letterkenny, Fr Denis Quinn, Glenties and Fr Joe O'Donnell, RIP, St. Johnston.
