The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Acts 2012-2016, which came into effect on 29 April 2016, makes it mandatory for people working with Children or Adults at Risk to be vetted by the Garda Síochána National Vetting Bureau. All diocesan personnel, clergy, paid workers and volunteers who have regular access to Children or Adults at Risk must undergo Garda Vetting. **This is the law.**

Due to Covid-19, any staff/volunteer who have been out of post for more than one year, now require re-vetting.
