Syria Appeal

Fr. Tony O'Riordan from Co Cork, is in charge of Jesuit Refugee Services in Syria and his team are very active on the ground in Syria and writes, 'The situation here is indescribably grim... As is often the case there is also hope and signs of light. I noticed with some of the team today, that with some help - now one week on - there was light back in their eyes. One father of two young children who said last week he could never go home out of fear- has gone back to his home tonight.. But the journey is long.. even those with light in their eyes - they confess that they cannot sleep at night.

For millions in the region, the light has yet to return to their eyes. For them aid has not reached them. There has been no one to stand with them - only tears to wipe the dust from their eyes. Homeless, grieving, terrified, hungry embraced only by the bitter cold and darkness.'
