Sacraments

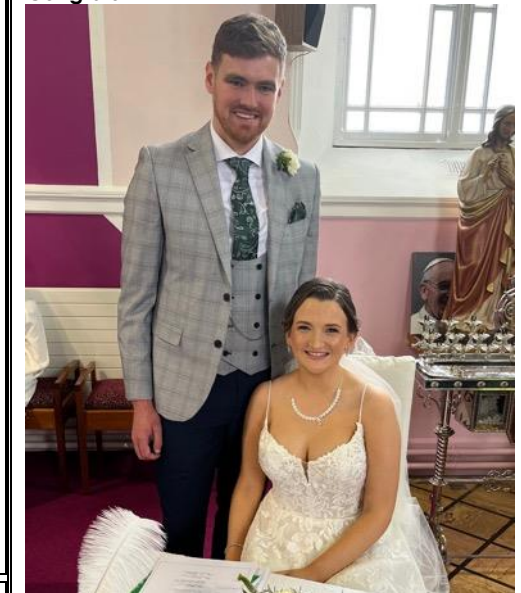
Baptisms are typically held in our parish on Saturdays at 2pm, a little later if there is a wedding. They are in Acres on the 1st and 3rd Saturday and in Kincasslagh on the 2nd and 4th. A fifth Saturday is where whoever asks first requests. Baptisms are together if requested on the same Saturday by more than one family. Marriage

Couples are asked to give three months' notice to the priest who will do their marriage papers. The priest responsible for your paperwork is the priest in the parish where you live and have been for at least 6 months. Priests understand that you may be only asking for paperwork and not to conduct the wedding. They will organise

that the paperwork be sent to the parish where your wedding will take place. You can choose whatever celebrant you want, but generally priests like to only be responsible for weddings within their own parish and with their own parishioners.

You need to fill in a pre-nuptial enquiry form with the priest responsible for your papers, but this will involve giving him a baptismal cert issued within the last three months and a certificate of confirmation. You normally organise the ceremony and a practice with your celebrant.
