As you may be aware, Uisce Éireann has been undertaking construction activities in Burtonport to end the discharge of untreated wastewater into Rutland Sound. In light of Burtonport Festival, 2023, Uisce Éireann alongside our delivery partner Veolia Water Ireland have been in close communications with local representatives to ensure minimal disturbance

from the construction works occurring alongside the Burtonport Ferry Terminal.
