### Carlo Acutis

(3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was an English-born Italian Catholic youth and website designer, who is best known for documenting Eucharistic Miracles around the world and cataloguing

them onto a website which he created before his death from Leukaemia. He was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist which became a core theme of his life. He was Beatified on 10 October 2020, two days before the 14<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his death.
