The Season of Creation: 1st Sept - 4th of October

"Let Justice and Peace Flow" is the theme of this year, inspired by the words of the prophet Amos: "Let justice flow on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream" (5:24). Pope Francis urges us to listen to the heartbeat of Creation. We can and must prevent the worst effects of climate change from happening, he writes. The Diocesan Justice and Peace Committee suggests to "green your parish and your home", for example to include Creation Care in prayers; to reduce, re-use, recycle & compost; to plant fruit trees, seeds & bulbs this month and to hold a cycle/walk to church.
