Letter from Civil Registrar to Solemnisers for the attention of couples preparing for Marriage

I write to you with regard to availability of access to Civil Registration Offices and with particular reference to couples who will contact you to book wedding dates. These couples will then subsequently need to make an in person appointment at a Civil Registration Office in order to serve 3 months statutory notice of their intention to marry and to collect their Marriage Registration Form. **The staffing and recruitment circumstances currently prevailing within the HSE nationally has impacted acutely on service availability in Civil Registration Co. Donegal and particularly in the Letterkenny Civil Registration Office.** The result is that the flexibility of date and time and the overall number of appointments on offer are now very much reduced. Couples who would normally choose to attend in person at the Letterkenny Civil Registration Office may find appointments available in one of the other Co. Donegal Offices i.e. Stranorlar or Bunrana. However, it is important to note that appointments may not be immediately available. Couples can also seek appointments in any Civil Registration Office nationally.
