Training is available for **seasoned or new catechists working with children, young people or adults**. This foundational course will take place **online over 6 weeks** (1 session per week) beginning **Thursday April 11th 2024 at 7.30pm**. Each session runs from 7.30pm to 9pm. 5. Methods and Resources for running a catechetical session.
6. Preparing for a catechetical session.
