The annual Burtonport festival night at the races takes place in The Lobster pot on Monday 30th December at 10pm. Horses will be on sale shortly at €10 each. See you there

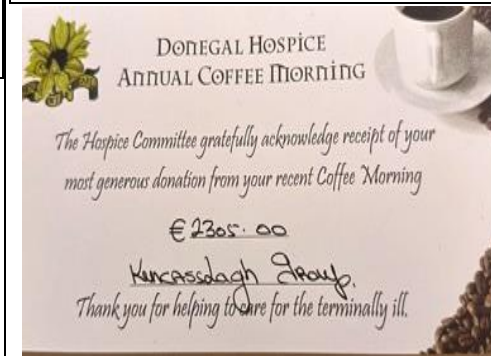
Keadue Rovers Bingo Results 11/10/2024
